2. Previous meeting record and matters arising

The following changes were made to the September 2008 minutes

- Date of meeting: delete December and insert September.
- Add Stephen Carroll, community member, to attendance list.

3. Contractor Overview

Andrew Rigby from Arenco reported that they are continuing with planning and preparation for works and are fencing under Cooper Road Bridge.

Mirza Sidiq from Gartner Rose reported they are undertaking planning and preparation prior to commencement. Work at Sefton station is expected to commence in early November.

4. Community Amenity Offset Plan (CAOP)

Discussion about the CAOP included:

- That the new lift planned for Sefton Station will be available for cyclists so no further works are required to ensure access for bikes.

- That whilst the planned landscaping will provide visual cover of the noise walls, in the short term graffiti may need to be managed via a maintenance program that includes immediate removal of any graffiti to discourage tagging. The landscape contract does include provision for watering plants and replacement of dead plants.
- Construction of cantilevered footpath at Wellington Road was clarified.
- The level crossing at Liverpool Hospital will be moved for safety reasons. Less traffic will use the crossing in its new location.
- The new project website was demonstrated, and is expected to “go live” on 5th September 2008. It is designed to be user friendly so that community members can keep up to date with the project.
