5. Out of Hours Work

Process and approval is determined by Dept of Environment and Climate Change

Sefton Station

- Construction will commence and out of hours work will continue on 16 and 17 May inclusive.
- All three (3) lifts at the station are going in at the same time.

Sefton St Footbridge

- There will be out of hours works and ARTC will look to see if the footbridge replacement can take place during night-time works so that access is maintained.

6. General Business and Action Items

- SSFL is a bi directional 36km project with one 2km passing loop.(at Glenfield)
- Phoenix (based at Junee) will control traffic on SSFL.

Noise Wall Finishes and Station Finishes

- May 13 CLG meeting will include a presentation on noise wall finishes
- A short list of finishes is being prepared by the Firm "Caldis Cook" and the CLG will be consulted -finishes will then go to the resident groups for consultation and final decisions made. Finishes must fit in with Council's overall urban design plans.

Noise walls:

- Noise walls will be constructed in the Chester Hill cutting area but stop in the Woods Road area. Under the approved project noise walls are only required to be installed where noise is increased by the SSFL track development
- A hotspots program is planned (but is not part of ARTC) for NSW-the Pollution Reduction Program (PRP) of Rail Corp will address particular noise sites
