1. Introductions and Apologies

3. Contractor/Construction Overview

A project update was given by Coral Reynolds and Paul Newcombe as per presentation.

Paul advised that the roundabout at Auburn Bridge was to be reinstated next week depending on inclement weather.

Coral advised that the temporary pedestrian crossing at Sefton Station on Wellington Road had been moved approximately 10 metres. The existing street lighting was found to be inadequate and posed a safety risk. Stations First had placed a daymaker at the crossing, and the nearby businesses and residents were doorknocked and advised of the installation of the daymaker with

generator. The noise from the generator powering the daymaker was monitored by the Stations First Safety and Environment Manager, and Project Manager and found the noise level to be within acceptable background noise guidelines.

4. Out of Hours Work

An update was given by Julie-Anne as per presentation.

5. General Business and Action Items

Artwork – Julie-Anne showed pictures of tiles that are part of the public art installation at Sefton Station. The art will be installed at the Station after the installation of the lift shaft to avoid damage to the art.

Noise Monitoring – Dale advised the meeting that noise monitoring had been undertaken next to the Neighbourhood Centre for the council. Julie-Anne will follow up with council and provide details to the CLG.

Repair work – Tim advised the meeting that 3A Rail had commenced restoration works at Birrong High School. This involves putting down the base layer for the tennis court which is located within the carpark at the 3A Rail Birrong Compound.

Bridges – Raymond raised the issue of bridges not being covered over as they are on other rail projects. JA will investigate and provide details to the CLG.

Landscaping – Tim advised the CLG that areas have been sprayed in preparation for spring planting as part of the Urban Design and Landscaping Plan. Soil erosion repair works will be undertaken prior to planting. The plants are currently scheduled for planting in spring as per the program.
