1. Introductions and Apologies

2. Previous meeting records and matters arising:

Previous Minutes: Rowan advised that the roundabout at Auburn Road was yet to be reinstated.

Matters arising: Nil

Action Items from previous minutes:

Noise Monitoring Julie-Anne advised she had investigated but was unable to determine the purpose of the noise monitoring.

Bridges – Raymond raised the issue of bridges not having sound barriers as they are on other rail projects. Julie-Anne will follow up with the ARTC Design Manager and provide details to the CLG.

3. Contractor/Construction Overview

A project update was given by Coral Reynolds as per the presentation.

Coral advised the CLG that the roundabout at Auburn Bridge was to be reinstated during September and October, and the majority of work in this LGA was landscaping as per the UDLP.

Coral advised that the works at Sefton Station were nearing completion with the indicative date the end of September. The remaining work would consist of artwork installation.

Tim noted that the majority of temporary fencing has been removed and permanent fencing installed in the Bankstown LGA.

4. Out of Hours Work

An update was given by Julie-Anne as per presentation. Tim requested that any out of hours work not completed within the month remain in the presentation until the works had been completed.

5. General Business and Action Items

Artwork – Julie-Anne advised that the artwork was still in production and would advise the indicative date of installation at the next CLG meeting.

Noise Walls – Ray enquired if noise walls would be installed opposite Birrong Swimming Centre on Wellington Road. Julie-Anne will advise Ray and bring the UDLP to every CLG meeting.

Landscaping – Rowan asked when the plants would be planted as per the UDLP. Tim advised this will be undertaken in the next month.

Bridges – Raymond raised the issue of bridges not having noise walls as on other rail projects. JA will investigate and provide details to the CLG. JA is waiting on a response from the Design Manager.

Auburn and Wellington Roads – Allan raised concerns about the poor visibility at Auburn Road Bridge believing it to be dangerous to motorists. Rowan advised that council had approached the RTA about installing lights at the intersection. This application was not approved with the council reinstating the roundabout as well as installing a speed cushion to reduce motorists speed.

Hector Street Underbridge – The CLG discussed the roadworks which were scheduled to be undertaken on Hector Street in May will now be completed in the next month after consultation with the nearby residents and businesses.
