1. Introductions and Apologies

Apologies were given for Allan Mansbridge.

2. Previous meeting records and matters arising:

Matters arising: Nil

Action Items from previous minutes:

Noise walls over bridges – Julie-Anne provided a response from ARTC Design and Environment Managers regarding bridges and noise barriers as per the presentation. Alternate treatments would be offered to affected residents where noise walls could not be installed.

Artistic fence – Donna asked about transparent artistic fence at Sefton Station. Julie-Anne advised that the artistic fence that will be installed will have visibility for emergency services and RailCorp.

Landscaping – Rowan advised the meeting that Council's arborist has identified locations for trees and will contact John Verhoeven to determine planting and species. Julie-Anne will meet with John Verhoeven on 24 October to discuss.

3. Contractor/Construction Overview

A project update was given by Martijn and Coral as per the presentation.

Dale advised the meeting of the article in The Torch 12 October edition discussing completion of the Auburn Road roundabout. Martijn advised there is approximately 10 days of work to be undertaken on the roundabout consisting of asphaltting and linemarking, with the completion date contingent on weather and other factors. Rowan asked if the temporary barriers at Tewinga Road adjacent to the roundabout can be removed. Rowan will send Martijn an email requesting the barriers to be removed. John Verhoeven will also follow up Rowan re his request to remove the temporary barriers.

Martijn also informed the meeting that:

- 3A Rail has been asked to build an access road east of Cooper Road. Julie-Anne will follow up with John Verhoeven.
- Testing and commissioning of the Sefton Dive pumpstation is to be undertaken at Sefton Road and has been delayed. Julie-Anne will check with the ARTC Environmental team re water sampling and testing.

Rowan advised the meeting that modifications are to be undertaken on the pedestrian crossings at Sefton Station.

4. Out of Hours Work

An update was given by Julie-Anne as per presentation.

Martijn explained what a Drott was to attendees and also advised that the installation of the gas main at Auburn Road will be undertaken in normal construction hours.

Donna asked if daymakers to be used on the out of hours works will shine into any residences. Julie-Anne advised that daymakers would only be faced into the corridor onto the work areas and not into residences, and that this has been toolboxed.

5. General Business and Action Items

Artwork – Julie-Anne advised that the artwork was still in production and would advise the indicative date of installation at the next CLG meeting.

November CLG – Donna advised that she will be absent for November's CLG meeting and will ask Rowena Lennings or Tim to chair on her behalf. Julie-Anne will be meeting with Rowena Lennings on 24 October to discuss.

Combined December CLG – Julie-Anne advised the meeting that the combined CLG will be held on 7 December with the venue to be determined. Natalie Boog from ARTC will be booking a venue in the next few weeks.
