4) Contractor Overviews

A status update given of the various sites as per the presentation.

Clarification was provided to the meeting of GST – Galvanised Steel Trunking. The meeting was advised that Bareena Street is in a partial state of completion, and that the works at Campbelltown Station are pending due to design issues.

5) Out of Hours Work

An overview of the January possession (2 – 17 January), and Weekends 29, 30, 31 and 34 was provided.

Q: - Will the new toilets at Cabramatta station be in operation prior to the demolishing of the old toilets?

A: - Yes

Attendees asked for clarification if the rail corridor would be closed from Sefton to Macarthur during the January possession. Attendees were advised that RailCorp as owners of the rail corridor would make this decision.

The meeting was advised that some works would be cancelled but ARTC were still required under the terms of the environmental licence to provide this information to the community.

6) February Works

An overview of construction work to be undertaken in February in normal construction hours was provided as per the presentation.

Leumeah Station

Q: - What is the timeline for the new noise walls?

A: - The noise walls will be done in stages.

Q: - Will they be constructed in advance of the track?

A: - After completion.

7) Public Art

An overview of the public art consultation process was provided as follows:

Bankstown

- Successfully completed two shopfront sessions (thanks Dale) and one door knock – offering residents the choice of four designs.
- The community selected a design and this has now been commissioned.
- Artists from Clayhouse are meeting with Sefton High School to finalise the youth involvement in the building of the artistic (mosaic) wall at Sefton Station. The school were delighted to participate.

Fairfield

- Met with Artists Pepperbox on 7/12/2010.
- Have finalised the contract details and the contract is now being developed.
- A timetable has been developed for approval.
- Meetings with Liverpool and Campbelltown Councils to confirm their public art process will take place within the next month.

Q: - Fairfield CLG has not had a presentation at this stage.

A: - Fairfield artists will come to the CLG meeting in February.

Q: - Will the youth be involved?

A: - Youth have been consulted about their emotive connection to place as part of the process and there will be more opportunities for youth involvement throughout the next stages of the consultation.

Q: - At which meeting will the art be presented.

A: - February. Artists are local. Themes will be consulted with the community.

8) General Business and Action items.

Q: - What is the final completion date of the SSFL project?

A: - Alan Warburton advised the meeting that ARTC Board approval for the final stage of the project will be in the next few months, and that the current indicative date is December 2012.

Q: - Is there monitoring of erosion at the various sites being carried out?

A: - The EMR is constantly monitoring sites and ARENCO is being utilised to undertake rectification if necessary.

Q: - Can the SSFL website have a schedule of milestones in place?

A: - Coral advised the meeting that the website was currently being updated and that this information would be included.

Q: - What is the period for noise monitoring after commissioning?

A:- Donna advised that under the terms of the EPL noise monitoring would be undertaken at commissioning, and then at 1, 3 and 5 years after completion.

Q: - Would the proposed intermodal transport interchange at Moorebank affect the project?

A: - This information was not available to the meeting.
