<p>3) <u>Contractor Overviews</u></p> <p>The following contractors gave an explanation of the current status of their respective areas of responsibilities.</p> <p>Arengo Bareena Street Overbridge</p> <p>Works on Bareena Street overbridge will involve a full closure. Saturday 6th March 1.00pm until 10.00pm Sunday 7th March 6.00am until 6.00pm</p>

Q: - Does the Council know?

A: - Yes, Fairfield Council is aware of these works.

Q: - When will this Bridge works be finished and opened to two-way traffic?

A: - End of March 2010

Q: - Have you taken into account Chinese New Year weekend?

A: - Yes, works will be limited as far as practicable, however the Bareena Street will have the current traffic arrangements in place.

Blue Circle Demolition.

ARTC has been communicating directly with Stella Howatt of Villawood Senior Citizens Centre.

Q: - How will you manage dust?

A: - By water suppression

Gartner Rose – Daniel Rose

An update of the current status at various sites was delivered as per the presentation.

Cabramatta Station

Gartner Rose confirmed that replacement parking would be made available before current parking spaces are lost.

Q: - How are you letting the community know about car parking changes?

A: - Letter box drops, windscreen drops and mailings to stakeholder list. Notifications will include a reminder that Area 1 is open.

O'Donnell Griffin

An update of the current status at various sites was delivered as per the presentation Cabramatta works.

4) Out of Hours Work

A briefing delivered by ARTC on the Out of Hours work proposed for the next few weeks as per the presentation.

Q: - Will the Bareena Street bridge be closed in February?

A: - Traffic arrangement will be the same as they are currently for the Month of February.

No further questions.

5) Urban Design and Landscaping Plan (UDLP)

A presentation on the UDLP was provided by a representative of Caldis Cook

Clarification was sought over a number of items relating to Cabramatta Station precinct.

Further to this discussion the following was confirmed:

- Broomfield Street will incorporate a slow speed zone where the bicycle zone will merge into the traffic zone.
- The toilet block at Cabramatta Station contains two toilets: one disabled toilet that can be used by the general public as well as by people with disabilities
- Council will be responsible for maintaining the toilets however the toilet block is self-cleaning
- The toilet block will cover a small part of the deflection wall. The deflection wall is the public art wall.
- The location of the toilets may create a gap in the range of the CCT camera operated by Council. These will be investigated by ARTC and Council.

Cabramatta Station Public Art Project

An organisation called Popperbox has been engaged to carry out the art works for Cabramatta Station. This organisation has been engaged by Council on other public art projects.

Q:- How is community consultation being managed by Popperbox?

A:- Taken on notice, ARTC will provide feedback at the next meeting.

Noise Walls:

It was confirmed that the noise walls are made from Hebel panels.

Climbing vines are being encouraged to cover panels where possible, as the best means to avoid graffiti.

Q:- How high are the Hebel panel noise walls

A:- 4.2 metres

Q:- Have the affected residents of Villawood been consulted. CLG member noted she was unaware of this.

A:- ARTC confirmed they had been consulted and that each CLG member had been telephoned to advise them of the direct noise wall consultation meeting time and venue.

Q:- Who will maintain the plantings?

A:- ARTC will maintain them for the first 12 months, then RailCorp will take over this responsibility.

Q:- What colour will the retaining walls be?

A:- Charcoal at base and cream above, as discussed and decided in the CLG Meeting previously.

Consultation over the UDLP

It was confirmed that the UDLP is on the website.

Its development has involved consultation with Council, the CLG and with residents neighbouring the noise walls.

ARTC view Council as the primary stakeholder in the Fairfield region and have aimed to promote consistency with existing themes in public spaces



Q:- Who will make the final call regarding the choice of public art?

A:- ARTC will following discussion with the CLG and Council and in consideration of the results of broader community consultation conducted by Popperbox.

Q: - Can the presentation be sent to the Chamber of Commerce in A3 format?

A: - Yes
