A: - The situation at Bareena Street, will be restored as it was previously, so the sign will be "No Right Turn – Buses Excepted"

#### **Gartner Rose – Daniel Rose**

An update of the current status of Cabramatta was delivered as per the presentation.

#### **Cabramatta Station**

Gartner Rose confirmed that replacement parking would be made available before current parking spaces are lost. At this stage the number of spaces is being kept in the credit.

Q: - Will the extra 42 spaces be completed by the end of March?

A: - No. Reed work in the area has to be completed prior to car parks being made available.

Q: - What is to be the width of the bikeway on the south side of the station.?

A: - Specified in the UDLP. Taken on notice.

Q: - The Bus shelter at the Cabramatta Station. What are the dimensions of the roof shelter?

A: - I will find out he dimensions and let you know.

#### **Carcoola Street**

Q: - The 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue pedestrian overbridge. Where is the protection screen situated?

A: - The Anti-throw screens are over the freight line, but not over the passenger section.

- 2) CLG to be updated regarding buses turning right onto Bareena Street Bridge from 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue after the completion of works.
- 3) CLG to be informed of the width of the Bikeway on the southern side of Cabramatta Station and the width of the shared pathway on the Prospect Creek bridge.

Q: - Is work going to start on Miller Road?

A: - Not at this stage. Miller Road is still part of the suspension and we will let you know when it will recommence.

Q: - When will the other works be recommenced?

A: - The CLG will be notified as soon as this information is available.

Q: - What will be the width of the shared pathway on the Prospect Creek bridge?

A: - ARTC will find out and advise at the following CLG.

Fairfield council raised the issue of tree removal and replacement by Reed construction. It was agreed that ARTC would respond to councils information request outside of the meeting
