<p><b>2) <u>Minutes</u></b> Corrections to Previous Minutes: - None</p> <p>Matters arising from previous Minutes:</p> <p>1) The dimensions of the Bus shelter at Cabramatta Station will be made available to the CLG when the design has been finalised</p> <p>The canopy on the top will be 2.5 Mtrs wide. Adshell will provide specifications which will be presented to the CLG.</p> <p>2) CLG to be updated regarding buses turning right onto Bareena Street Bridge from 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue after the completion of works.</p> <p>The Bareena Street “No Right Turn” sign has been reinstated.</p>

- 3) CLG to be informed of the width of the Bikeway on the southern side of Cabramatta Station and the width of the shared pathway on the Prospect Creek bridge.

The bike path will be 1.2 metres wide on the new section.

Q: - Will danger signs be installed for pedestrians on the shared pathway?

A: - Council will be complying with recommendations from the traffic committee

Q: - There will be two walkways on the Prospect Creek Bridge.?

A: - The new pedestrian path will be 1.8 Metres wide and there is only one. The existing one will be made redundant and there will be signage for the shared cycleway.

The old traffic lines on Broomfield Street which have been blacked out are showing through on the road which has the potential to confuse drivers.

The new lines will be remarked and the old lines blacked out again.

Q: - The final design of the Cabramatta Street fencing. What noise mitigation properties does it have?

A: - None. It is a perforated fence.

Q: - Then train noise will come through to the shopping centre?

A: - The fence is not a noise mitigation fence. There are different guidelines for Commercial, Industrial and Residential areas. The placement of the noise walls has been approved and ARTC has met the guidelines.
