An update given of the status of various sites as per the presentation.

**Sewer Main Diversion on Broomfield Street**

Q: - Will the setting up of the work have any impact?

A: - There will be traffic and pedestrian impacts and minimal impacts on parking.

**Blue Circle Demolition.**

Q: - Who owns the site?

A: - RailCorp

Q: - Does RailCorp own up to the fence line?

A: - Yes.

The EMR made comment that all steel and concrete from the site is being recycled.

CG member made comment that there has been no trouble from the site.

**Cabramatta Station**

Q: - How long before the lift is operational?

A: - Handover of the station is approximately end of August .

Q: - Will the new toilets be installed?

A: - The existing toilets will remain until the new ones are installed.

The UDLP details are close to being presented to the Department of Planning

Council comments have been closed out.

Q: - Will the CLG have feedback on the Artwork as part of the UDLP?

A: - Yes, the Artwork process will go through the CLG for comment and input.

Q: - What is the timing of the public art consultations?

A: - Not finalised as yet. They will be presented to the CLG.

Project start-up and completion will affect artwork consultation timelines. Dates will be given to the CLG when project restart and completion dates are known.

Council is happy to show CLG members comments made regarding the UDLP.

**5) General Business and Action items.**

Council made note that there have been complaints from pedestrians going to cars that the lights are not functioning on the power poles opposite the Leisure Centre in the newly constructed parking spaces.

Gartner Rose will investigate.

Q: - Is there anything more happening on the Miller Road works (Note Bankstown LGA). It is difficult to negotiate the road as there are holes on the edge of the asphalt?

A: - This area is part of the suspension. The pavement on either side of the bridge has failed, this condition is pre-project and Bankstown Council is aware of the issue. ARTC's design will not fix this existing problem.

Q: - Is there any further information regarding the Project restart?

A: - Not at this stage. The project is still under suspension. As soon as new information is available the CLG will be informed.
