Cabramatta Station

CLG commented that the letter was well written and conveyed their concerns well.

ARTC informed the CLG that a new staff member to support the Community Liaison Manager was starting on Monday 12th July. ARTC also conveyed that the Hotline handling is being redistributed to ease the workload including after hours and weekends.

EMR informed the CLG that the Miller Road over bridge work was a 12 week program and has asked the constructors to look at pedestrian signage and extra barrier fencing in key spots.
