<p><b>1) <u>Welcome, introductions, Apologies</u></b></p> <p>The Chair welcomed meeting attendees, introductions were made and apologies were noted.</p>
<p><b>2) <u>Minutes</u></b></p> <p>The minutes from the previous CLG meeting were accepted with no modifications required.</p>
<p><b>3) <u>Contractor Overviews</u></b></p> <p>An update was given of the various work sites as per the presentation.</p> <p>3ARail corrections: 15A2 Endeavour Energy underline crossing, Longfield Street to McBurney Rd – Connections in mid to late August, subject to Endeavour Energy power outage. Cabramatta sewer realignment, Broomfield Street – Manhole construction at Ch270 ongoing.</p> <p>Public Art Update corrections: Bob Ford is ARTC not Stations First</p>

**5) Public Art Update**

Julie-Anne advised the CLG on the further process of the Fairfield Public art, as per presentation.

Marzi queried if all items included in the budget were specified in the SSFL Community Amenity Offset Plan or if this was an interpretation? Julie-Anne advised that yes, this was noted in past meeting notes that all items were included and agreed on.

**6) General Business and Action items.**

6 July 2011: Marzi queried the status of fencing at Cabramatta Station as this item had previously been raised at CLG meetings but had dropped off subsequent minutes. Coral will advise the CLG at the next meeting re: the status of fencing.

3 August 2011: Marzi again raised concern about safety of fence if it is to remain long term

- *Coral not present to advise of her findings. Brad Begley advised that the temporary fence has been secured to make safe. The current fence structure would stay until the next stage works, which are not far away.*

Charles (CLG member) made it very clear that he was unimpressed and annoyed with ARTC regarding the demolition of the old Cabramatta Station toilet block. He said that the CLG was promised in the past that the toilet block would not be demolished before the new amenities were open to the public and he feels no consideration has been given to the residents and visitors of Cabramatta. He requested for ARTC to provide some porta loos instead until the Exiloo is opened to the public.

- Marzi (Fairfield Council) advised that this issue is not in ARTC's hands as it was an internal issue which had to be resolved between RailCorp and Council (currently raised to Ministerial level).
- Julie-Anne advised she would investigate the status of the Ministerial and give an update about this issue at the next CLG regarding the use of the Exiloo.

Charles also advised he had not seen any signs regarding the closure of the toilets.

- Brad Begley and ARTC assured Charles that signs were put up 5 days prior to demolition and they were still displayed at present. Brad Begley told the CLG that he would inspect first thing in the morning to confirm that the signage was still erected in the appropriate locations.
- ***ACTION: Stations First and ARTC investigation confirmed that the signs are still on display advising the public of the closure and other available public amenities in the vicinity of the station. Photos will be presented at the next CLG. Action now closed***

Krystyna (Polish Hall) advised the CLG about that the large pothole in car park at Broomfield Street Cabramatta under bridge and that it has still not been repaired (apparently she mentioned this before to the CLG) and she felt it was a safety hazard. Brad Begley told the CLG that he would inspect the next day.

- ***ACTION: On inspection Brad advised Julie-Anne that the pothole could be repaired by 3ARail by COB Friday 5 August 11. 3A Rail confirmed on Monday 8 August 11 that pothole has been repaired. Action now closed.***
