**1) Welcome, introductions, Apologies**

The Chair welcomed meeting attendees, introductions were made and apologies were noted.

**2) Minutes**

The minutes from the previous CLG meeting were discussed and the following modifications were noted:

- Re: Cabramatta Station toilet block – Charles relayed his concerns relating to ARTC closing the toilet block without providing the opening of the Exeloo at the same time. Charles also commented that after the last CLG meeting he had concerns about no signage to the community re: the alternative public toilets but then after the CLG meeting that night, he went down and took photos of the existing signs and they were in place, per ARTC's instruction. Pictures were also shown at the CLG.
- Charles commented on previous minutes and stated that they are very good.
- Marzi commented that the Exeloo opening was not entirely in ARTC's hands and that the matter was now with RailCorp and Fairfield City Council to agree upon.



### 3) Contractor Overviews

#### **3ARail corrections:**

- Cabramatta Station – Broomfield Street near Longfield Street works to commence. Expected during is **3 weeks** NOT 6 weeks.

3ARail additional comments:

- **Traffic lights – Broomfield Street** – now approved
- **Footpath refurbishment** – Broomfield Street – explained that ARTC is currently investigating and consulting with the businesses and community – Marzi De Santi agreed to write a letter from Fairfield City Council accepting their support for the work to be conducted out of hours.

- Construction work from Leightonfield Station to Carramar Station - Clarification was required with the dates for construction and now confirmed as correct for four weekends between 15 October and **25 December 2011 (is due to contingency)**.
