1) Welcome, introductions, Apologies

The Chair welcomed meeting attendees, introductions were made and apologies were noted.

Donna thanked Tim for chairing the previous CLG meeting in her absence.

2) Minutes

The minutes from the previous CLG meeting were modified as follows:

- Marzi advised that in the August minutes it was ARTC's decision to demolish the toilet at Cabramatta station, however, the matter was with RailCorp and Fairfield City Council to agree upon.
- Tony Fornasier was present at the previous CLG meeting but was noted as absent.
- Marzi advised that in relation to the footpath refurbishment works at Broomfield Street Fairfield City Council would review the proposed out of hours works then consider drafting a letter in support of the out of hours works.



3) Contractor Overviews

An update was given of the various work sites as per the presentation.

It was noted that the tree trimming works at Wellington Road, Chester Hill was awaiting Bankstown Council approval.

Footpath refurbishment works at Broomfield Street – paving works are scheduled to commence on 21 October subject to DPI approval. Marzi advised he had sent an email to Bob Ford and Brad Begley that the council raised no objections to the out of hours works.

4) Out of Hours Work

OOH work provided as per the slides.

Clarification was sought on slide 1 that the works will be undertaken on 8 and 9 October.

Tim explained the wing wall work at Miller Road, Villawood and what a Drott is.

Stella asked if the works at Miller Road was on the factory side. It was confirmed that they were.

Tim requested the out of hours works to be undertaken till the end of December 2011 remain in the CLG presentations until the works have been completed. Donna requested that an update be provided at each CLG meeting until the works have been completed.

No further questions.

5) Public Art Update

Coral provided an update of the noisewall consultation with Krystyna Cyron on 5 October 2011. Krystyna provided feedback on the ribbon designs presented.

Charles asked if the journey was still the design for the artwall at Cabramatta Station and this was confirmed. The community members attending expressed their opposition to the council logo being used on the noisewall and this was noted.

Marzi noted that he thought an element of the artwall design was to be used on the noisewalls reflective of the journey. This was confirmed.

Julie-Anne advised that there will be a meeting with Popperbox and Marla Gupi on 10 October 2011 to reiterate that an element of the journey is to be transferred to the noisewalls, which will then be presented to Krystyna Cyron. A presentation will be made to the CLG once the noisewall design has been finalised.

6) General Business and Action items.

Footpath refurbishment works at Broomfield Street:

- Julie-Anne clarified why the Broomfield Street paving works required approval from DPI as the works are being undertaken outside the rail corridor.
- Brad explained that the noisiest works will be undertaken between 8 – 10pm, pouring concrete will be done between midnight and 4am, with paving to be done from 4am. The timing of the works is to be clarified with the contractor.
- Marzi asked if new kerb and guttering is to be done. Brad clarified that this will be done.



- Ray asked if the work will continue from the Bakery to the Doctor's Surgery. Brad clarified that the paving works will be done from the Bakery along Broomfield Street to the lane next to the Stardust Hotel and Red Flame Kitchen.
- Coral Reynolds is to ensure that there are no residents living above the Broomfield Street shops as requested by DPI and to advise ARTC of this.

Julie-Anne showed the CLG members a diagram of works completed to date and the key milestones yet to be achieved.

Charles requested he be given a copy of the CLG presentation prior to attending the meeting.
