**1. Welcome, introductions, previous meeting record and matters arising - Chair**

The Chair welcomed meeting attendees and made introductions.

**2. Previous Minutes**

Previous meeting minutes were endorsed as true and correct.

**3. Contractors Construction Overview – Reed**

An introduction to the meeting and an overview of the area's of responsibility of the contractor was presented to the meeting.

Q: Where do your area's extend?

A: Cabramatta to Woodville. Woodville to Macarthur

Q: Any ideas of when you will be starting?

A: Glenfield area foundations and Piling. Nothing heavy until service searching finishes in 3 – 4 weeks.

Q: Are you doing the bridge?

A: Yes.

Q: Is there going to be noise mitigation at the bridge?

A: Concrete sleeper will be used.

An introduction from Daniel Rose from Gartner Rose contractors and an overview of areas of responsibility and current status.

Q: Woodville to Fairfield and Casula will be together?

A; Both.

**4. Out of Hours Work**

A slide presentation and overview given by Prue Hodgson of out of hour's work being planned. Work on the 21<sup>st</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> March coming up.

Q: Could you describe the piling works?

A: It is sandy soil. There will be a low hum of the drill.

Q: Will there be concrete pouring and drilling during the day?

A: Yes.

Q: Any traffic access issues?

A: If streets are used then approvals will be done and notifications sent out.

Q: Can notices be at least 2 weeks beforehand?

A: Notices between 14 – 7 days beforehand. There has to be a balance between sufficient time and accuracy.

Q: Minimum of 7 days?

A: Yes. (Notifications of out of hours work). We try for 14 days. There is usually initial notification then follow-ups.

Q: Along the Casula Golf Course - how are you building the track up?

A: Survey works are still being done. 2 – 3 weeks.

Q: How much wider and how will you fill in the wall.

A: This is on the agenda for the next meeting. Golf course and access road at Casula.

DECC is the ultimate authority for approval. The application will be reviewed before work starts.
