##### **Warwick farm station**

Q: - How many car parks have been removed?

A: - 9 - 10.

Q: - Residents have complained of car parks being lost.

A: - TIDC has been working on the multi-story car parks. ARTC has already constructed a carpark, so currently due to our works there is no net loss of car parking and an increase in the total number of commuter car parks available at Warwick Farm.

**Casula**

Liverpool Council request that ARTC consult with the Power House Museum regarding works in the area.

ARTC will ensure this is done.

Q: - The lifts at Casula station. Will the RailCorp ones be constructed first?

A: - All three will be done at the same time.

Q: - Are the lift shafts concrete?

A: - Steel

Council raised concern about graffiti.

Lifts will have Anti-Graffiti coating.

**Water Crossing 43**

Q: - Are there to be any road closures?

A: - No. TCP is in place.

**REED – Glenfield area**

There will be a high volume of truck traffic in the area delivering 15,000 tons of fill. There will be upwards of 40 trucks per day.

In order to reduce noise impacts “Quackers” rather than “Beepers” are used for plant on site.
