1. Welcome, introductions, apologies

CLG agreed to John Murray chairing the meeting in the absence of Rowena Lennings.

2. Previous Minutes record and matters arising

Previous meetings Minutes reviewed:

Page 2, Contractor Overviews, Casula, Line 5, "A: - All three will be done at the same time." Amended to "A: - The three lifts may not be craned in together but the aim is to have the three opening at the same time."

No further alterations. Accepted as correct.

Matters arising: -

Action Items –

3. Contractor overviews

An update given by contractors of the present status of works in the Liverpool CLG area as per the presentation.

Minto Station

The EMR has completed an audit of the Minto station works and has recommended the laying of turf and some extra sandbags. The site was clean and tidy.

ARTC received a complaint from a business owner who was concerned about draining in regards to final design. An on site inspection and explanation of the drainage was given by ARTC and the customer was satisfied with the arrangements.

Wet weather has delayed some works.

Leumeah

New car park is beginning within the week.

Warwick Farm Station

Still in credit in terms of car parks.

Council reiterated that spaces were to be kept in credit.

The new footbridge will be craned in with a 500 ton crane which has to be set up in the car park from 31st July – 1st Aug. This will require closure of the car park until the operation has been completed.

Q: - Will this operation require road closures?

A: - The crane will occupy the Warwick Street car park. It may require temporary road closures when moving in.

Liverpool City Council reiterated that dilapidation reports will be needed.

The suburb will require extensive notification.

Q: - Is the operation planned for night or day?

A: - The crane will be brought in out of hours. It will be under escort and will arrive at 6.00am from Newcastle. The works will continue for the weekend and there will be extensive Out of Hours over the weekend at Warwick Farm Station.

4. Out of Hours Work

Overview presented of out of hours work to be undertaken in the next few weeks as per the presentation.

Q: - What has been the reaction to the use of “Quackers” with the machinery.

A: - Very positive response to the use of “Quackers”. Far less intrusive than the beepers.
