A project update was provided by the ARTC Project Management team believe we went straight into contractor overviews?

### **4. Contractor overviews**

ARTC Communications Manager and ARTC Project Engineer – Future Works provided an overview of the 3A Rail works in the Liverpool and Campbelltown areas as per the presentation.

A special note was made that the Casula Access Road works were commencing after the launch of the NRL season at the Casula Powerhouse. ARTC and the Casula Powerhouse team are coordinating the overflow parking arrangements for the event.

The ARTC Communications Manager and ARTC Project Engineer – Stations provided an overview of Stations First works in the Liverpool and Campbelltown areas as per the presentation.

### **5. Out of Hours Work**

Details were provide for out of hours works

- Removal of Power Pole 48 and installation of a new pole at Atkinson Street WE37 or WE38 or WE39 – 12-13, or 19-20 or 26-27 March 2011.  
Three weekends have been nominated at this date due to RailCorp power outages and resourcing. Only one of the nominated weekends will be utilised for the works (i.e. 2 days of works) and the community will be notified of the final weekend dates only.
- Installation of two new power poles at Casula  
One weekend in March or April 2011 and a contingency weekend in March or April 2011.  
These works are completely reliant on the network operator (Integral Energy) providing outages. The community will be notified of the actual dates.
- Sewer connection works at Glenfield  
WE36, WE37, WE38 or WE39 – 5-6, 12-13, 19-20 or 26-27 March 2011  
Any two weekends of night work in March 2011.  
These works are completely reliant on the network operator (Integral Energy) providing outages. Only two of the nominated weekends will be utilised for the works and the community will be notified of the final weekend dates only.

An overview was given of the consultation process to be employed for OOH works as per the presentation.

A special note was made that ARTC is using a new distributor for notifications

which will allow for faster turnaround times and more accuracy in notifying residents of construction dates.
