Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Campbelltown

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction works in your area over the weekend of the 20th and 21st February 2010. These works are part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL).

North Campbelltown – These works will begin at 7.00am and continue until 7.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve excavation work, protection of existing services and some formwork around the gas main and a slab pour. The equipment used will be back hoe, dig, concrete trucks, welding and gas axe.

Queen Street, Campbelltown – These works will begin at 7.00am and continue until 5.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve the protection of existing Integral Energy cable route, where it crosses the new freight line at Campbelltown. The equipment used will be vacuum truck, excavator, compaction tools and hand tools.

Campbelltown Yard Under Track Crossing– The works will begin at 7.00am and continue until 6.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve overhead wiring adjustments, and Under Track Crossing. The equipment used will be hi-rail cherry pickers, Manitou (cranes), 5t excavators, dumpy trucks, tipper trucks, bobcats, and concrete trucks.

Campbelltown Yard Over Head Wiring -These works will begin at 7.00am and will continue until 6.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve the over head wiring adjustments. The equipment used will be hi-rail cherry pickers, Manitou (Crane) and 5t excavator.

Farrow Road, Campbelltown – These works will be from 7.00am and continue until 7.00pm on both Saturday and Sunday. The works will involve the relocation of poles, dismantling overhead wires and excavating work. The equipment used will be crane, pole truck, bucket truck, light vehicles, and small excavators.

Campbelltown Station – These works will begin at 8.00am on Saturday 20th Feb and will continue until 10.00pm on Sunday 21st Feb 2010. The works will involve the erection of a steel and precast footbridge and two spans, precast stairs, roof

structural steel and roof sheeting. The equipment used will be 120t crane, franna crane, oxy sets, delivery trucks and scaffolding.
