Notice of construction works

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction works within the rail corridor in your area over the weekend of 7th and 8th February 2009.

These works are part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL). The SSFL is an initiative by ARTC that will improve the efficiency and competitiveness of rail freight services along the rail lines linking Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane. This will increase the use of rail for freight and is better for the environment as rail services have less impact than trucks. The SSFL is a 36 kilometre dedicated freight line between Macarthur and Sefton and the new track is within the existing rail corridor. The SSFL will allow passenger and freight services to operate independently, freeing up passenger lines for improved services.

The activities planned for the weekend of the 7th and 8th February 2009 will involve fencing, vegetation clearing, piling and excavation and there will be truck movements through the area.
