IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION WORK COMMENCES ON CASULA STATION UPGRADE

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) has commenced work on the Easy Access upgrade at Casula Station. Casula Station is to undergoing an upgrade to make train travel from this station more accessible for customers.

Features of the upgrade include:

- New station entry stairs
- Three new lifts
- Extension of existing footbridge over Southern Sydney Freight Line
- Upgraded CCTV and signage.

Please be aware that there is a presence of construction workers and building equipment at Casula Station. We apologise for any inconvenience caused during the execution of this work. Completion of this work will increase the safety, comfort and accessibility at the station. This upgrade will greatly benefit the local community and make it easier for families and seniors to use public transport.

These works form part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL), an initiative by ARTC to improve the efficiency and competitiveness of rail freight services. This will increase the use of rail for freight and is better for the environment as rail services have less impact than trucks. The SSFL is a 36 kilometre dedicated freight line between Macarthur and Sefton and the new track is within the existing rail corridor. The SSFL will allow passenger and freight services to operate independently, freeing up passenger lines for improved services.
