ROAD CLOSURE – AUBURN ROAD

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction works at the Auburn Road overbridge and will need to reclose the Auburn Road on the **16th November 2009**.

The closure will be the same as the previous closure, with the only change being the worksite will be on the western side of the bridge. The Auburn Road closure is a one way closure, allowing only northbound traffic through, and southbound buses. Southbound traffic on Auburn Road will detour left into Bagdad Street, continue on Bagdad into Cooper Road and then turn right onto Rodd Street, then left into Auburn Road. Traffic control (flagmen) will be in place to manage the traffic changes.

Southbound heavy vehicles will be re-routed to the nearest parallel heavy vehicle routes on Hector Street and Rookwood Road.

The closure will be effective from the 16 November 2009 until approximately February 2010.

These works form part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL). The SSFL is a 36 kilometre dedicated freight line between Macarthur and Sefton and the new track is within the existing rail corridor. The SSFL will allow passenger and freight services to operate independently, freeing up passenger lines for improved services and providing more capacity for freight trains on the dedicated lines.
