Southern Sydney Freight Line MINTO STATION - UPDATE

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) has commenced works at Minto Station. These works involve the construction of 3 new passenger lifts to improve access, the extension of the existing footbridge and the demolition of the existing western ramp. The current western stairs will be replaced with a new set of stairs. The new bus shelters have already been opened to the public on the SSFL side.

To begin works on the Eastern lift shaft the existing bus shelter on Minto Road must be moved temporarily. This will be removed on the 7th December 2009 and will be replaced once the lift shaft is finalised in approximately March 2010.

- Construction of the new carparking is progressing and will be opened to the public as soon as possible.
- During construction there will be some changes to public access to the station to allow the lift construction to begin.
- Pedestrian access to the station will be maintained.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused during the execution of this work. Completion of this work will increase the number of station parking spots, as well as increase the comfort and accessibility commuting to the station. This upgrade will greatly benefit the local community and make it easier to use public transport.
