Bareena Street Overbridge Works

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) has been undertaking construction works at the Bareena Street Overbridge. On 4th February 2010 we are programmed to install the bridge planks on Bareena St. We intend to use west street to temporarily park two articulated delivery vehicles containing the bridge planks whilst a third delivery vehicle is being unloaded. We will have traffic controllers on site to coordinate all vehicle movements, in particular insuring resident access is maintained at all times.

The delivery of the planks is scheduled for Thursday 4th February 2010.

There will be a total of three vehicles that will utilise West Street as a temporary staging area. Traffic controllers will be present to ensure pedestrian and private vehicle access is not impeded. Please contact the information line below if you require further detail.

These works form part of the construction of the Southern Sydney Freight Line (SSFL). The SSFL is a 36 kilometre dedicated freight line between Macarthur and Sefton and the new track is within the existing rail corridor. The SSFL will allow passenger and freight services to operate independently, freeing up passenger lines for improved services and providing more capacity for freight trains on the dedicated lines.
