Changed traffic conditions at Campbelltown Station

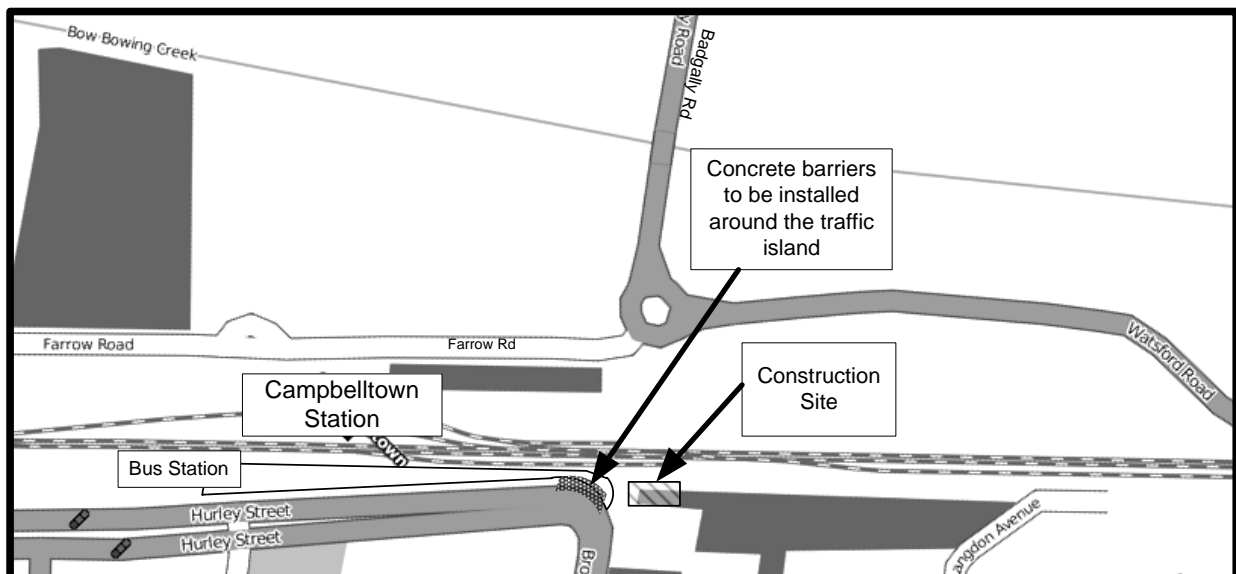
Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work adjacent to Campbelltown Station from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturday.

A construction site will be established in the station carpark from 27 April to 30 June 2011. Seven parking bays will be occupied during this time. The disabled parking bays adjacent to the station will be retained and moved to the next available spaces. Pedestrian access to the station via the carpark will be maintained throughout construction.

In association with this work concrete barriers will be installed around the traffic island on Broughton Street at 9.30am on 11 April 2011. This will take four hours and traffic will be reduced to one lane. The traffic island will then be closed to pedestrians for the duration of the works.

The existing width of the bus lane on Broughton Street will be unaffected; however, the width of the outer lane on Broughton Street will be slightly reduced.

Traffic controls will be in place during this time to manage vehicular and pedestrian movements.
