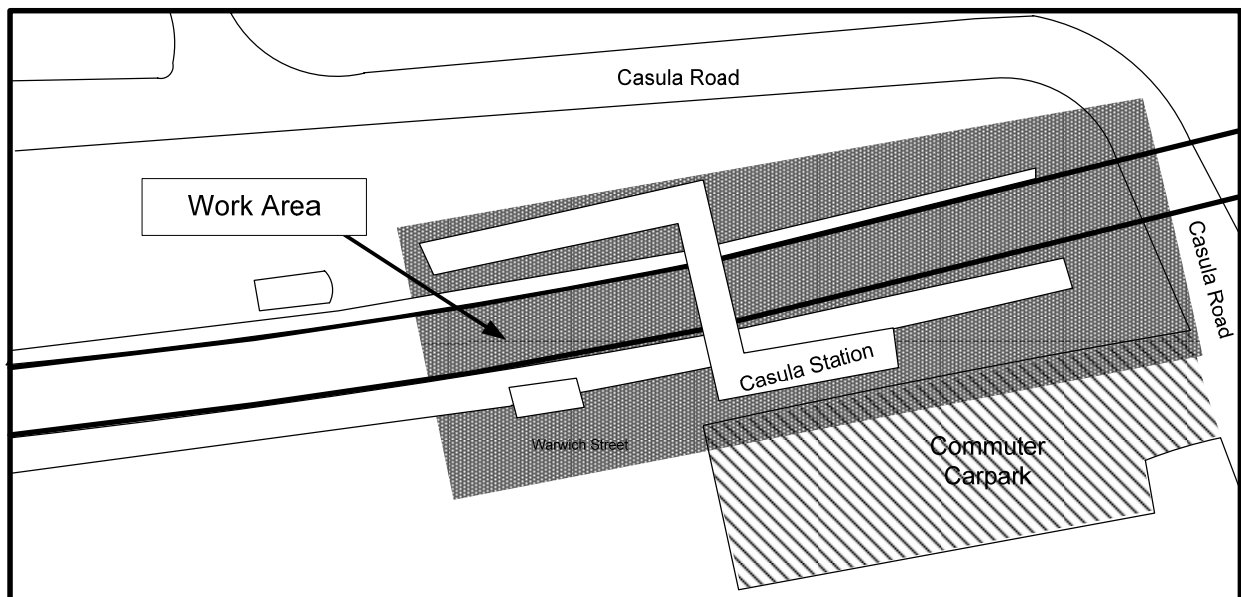
Construction Work at Casula Station

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work at Casula Station. This work must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks.

Works to the lift shafts, footbridge, extension of the deflection wall and a power upgrade will take place from 7am to 6pm Saturday 7 May and 8am to 6pm Sunday 8 May 2011. An approved contingency period is in place from 6pm to 10pm on both Saturday 7 May and Sunday 8 May 2011.

The installation of the lift shafts will take place from 7am to 6pm Saturday 14 May and 8am to 6pm Sunday 15 May 2011. An approved contingency period is in place from 6pm to 10pm on both Saturday 14 May and Sunday 15 May 2011.

The equipment used will include delivery trucks, oxy sets, a 100T or 250T crane, 20T franna, scaffolding, an elevated work platform, generator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
