Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Glenfield Site Compound, Glenfield Road

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be constructing a temporary site compound off Glenfield Road (refer to diagram), as part of the Southern Sydney Freight Line project. ARTC is working with Liverpool City Council to ensure the site compound is harmonious to your neighbourhood. The compound will be kept as minimal in size as practical for its purposes, with sufficient distance from any neighbouring properties and using existing trees where possible to screen the compound.

The compound will be used to provide office space, storage, deliveries and parking for up to 100 workers. A benefit is that it allows for adequate space for all employees to park in the designated compound area, with no need to use local residential streets. The compound is to be located approximately 40 metres from the properties on Slessor Road and 55 metres from those on Glenfield Road., The compound will be in place for a period of approximately 18 months.

The truck route to the site will be via Glenfield Road. Trucks will only be permitted to make a left turn into the compound from Glenfield Road and trucks exiting the compound will be directed to turn left onto Glenfield Road.

A small number of trees on the Glenfield Road frontage may need to be removed to provide access to the site. Tree removal will be minimised and any existing trees between the compound and Glenfield Road will be maintained to screen the compound and retain a sense of greenery from the road and public view. The site will be rehabilitated to its original state on completion of the works. A solid fence will also be erected to the rear and sides of the compound to minimise the potential for noise and visual impacts.

The existing pedestrian cycleway between the residential properties and the compound will not be obstructed or used at any time during construction.

In accordance with our approval requirements, the operation of the site compound will be Monday to Friday 7.00am to 6.00pm, Saturdays 8.00am and 1.00pm. At times office staff may access the compound outside of these hours to undertake primarily administration tasks.

We will provide a community notification advising you of any 'out of hours' construction activities in the future.

Works are proposed to start on the temporary site compound during the first week of October 2011, weather permitting.

We appreciate your patience while we occupy this land to complete this important project for Sydney and NSW.
