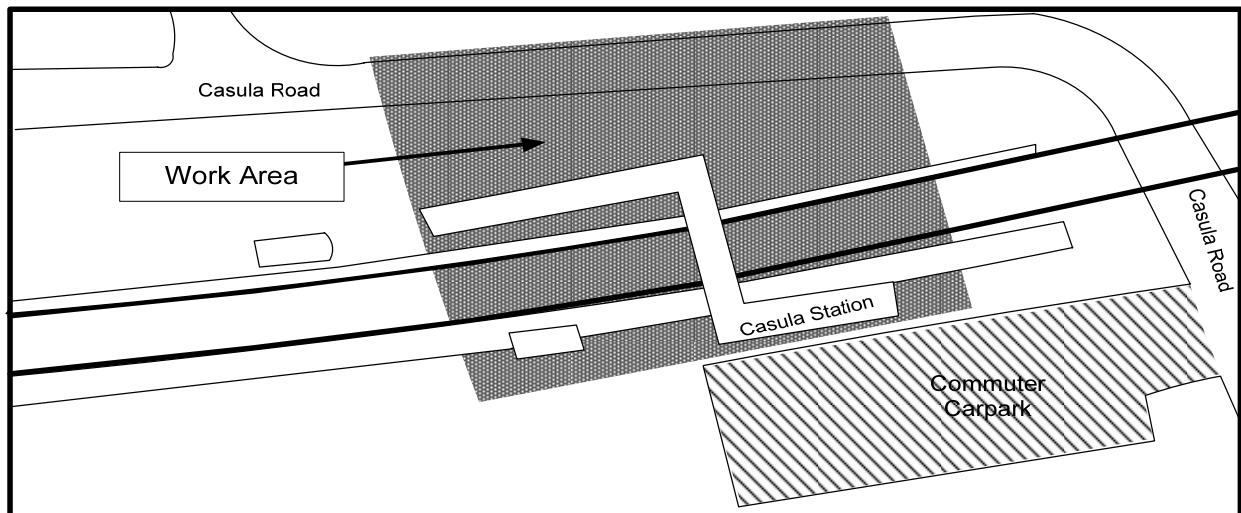

Construction Work at Casula Station

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work at Casula Station. This work must be undertaken outside of normal construction hours because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires. Therefore ARTC has to utilise a weekend where RailCorp has a high voltage line power outage scheduled and the Casula Powerhouse Museum is closed.

The installation of the bridge components between the lift shafts across the future SSFL track will take place from 7am Saturday 8 October to 11am Sunday 9 October 2011. Once the bridge work has been completed work will continue to reinstate the high voltage line at Casula Station, which has been approved to take place until 6pm on Sunday 9 October 2011 (weather permitting).

The equipment will include a 130t crane, 20t franna, mobile scaffold, 2x elevated work platform, knuckle boom, generator, 25t mobile crane, concrete truck, pole truck with hydraulic lift, pot hole truck, 12t excavator, auger, truck and trailer for spoil removal, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
