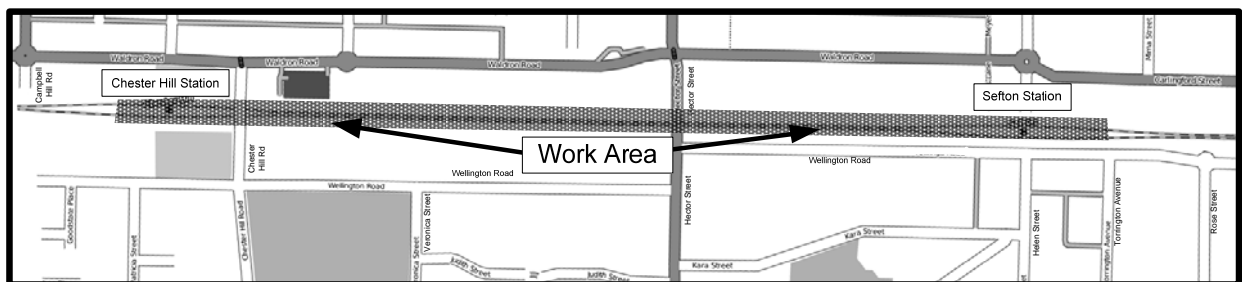
Construction Works from Sefton to Chester Hill

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks.

Sefton Station to Chester Hill Station

The removal of redundant power poles will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday, on Saturday 22 October and 29 October and on Sunday 30 October 2011 (weather permitting).

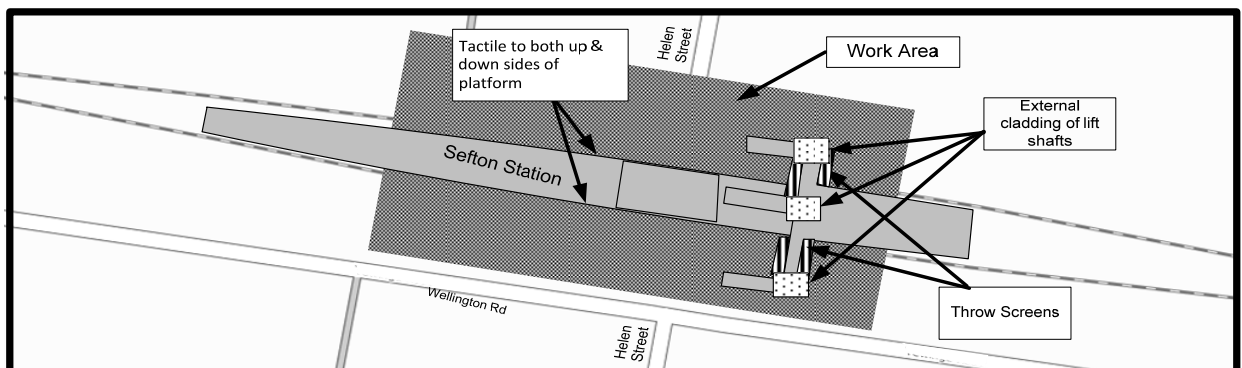
The equipment required for these works will include a 50t crane, 20t franna crane, hi-rail Manitou, pole truck, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Sefton Station

Station works, including power upgrade works, works to the pedestrian bridge and stairs, platform works, lift shaft and footbridge works will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on Saturday 22 October and Sunday 23 October, and on Saturday 29 October and Sunday 30 October 2011. An approved contingency from 6pm to 10pm is in place for all days worked (weather permitting).

The equipment required for these works will include a 20t franna crane, mobile scaffold, elevated work platforms, oxy set, concrete saw, generator, scaffold, knuckle boom, generator, scissor lift, delivery vehicles, and powered and non-powered hand tools.

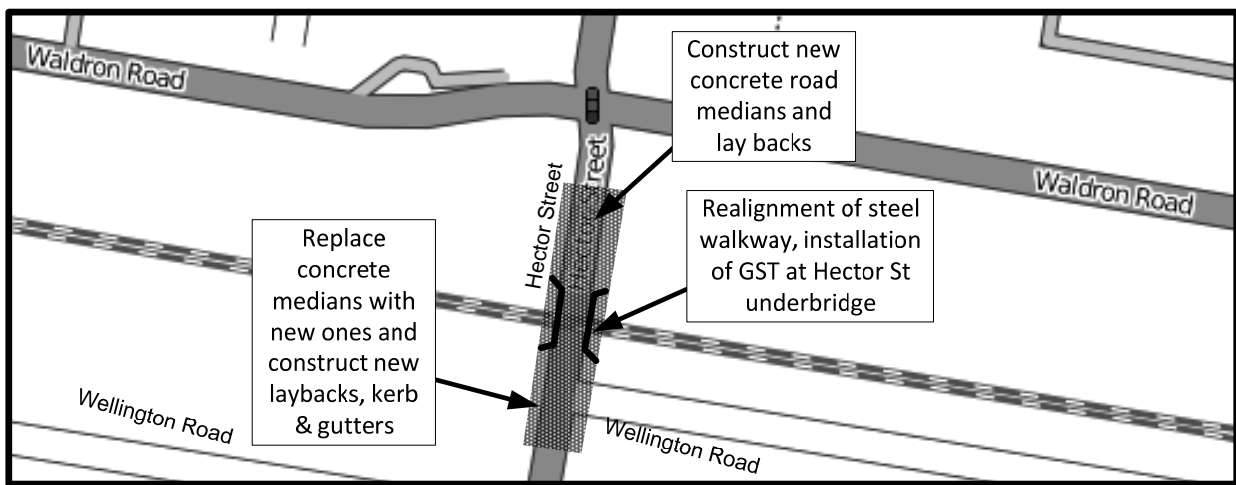


Hector Street, Chester Hill

Road works, including the replacement of existing kerb gutters and the footpath, and new line marking, laybacks and signs, will be undertaken from 7am and 6pm on Saturday 29 October and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday 30 October 2011. An approved contingency from 6pm to 10pm is in place for both days worked (weather permitting). All works are programmed for completion during the day, however road line marking may need to overrun into the evening period.

As a road closure is required, this work must be undertaken outside of normal construction hours to minimise disruption to local residents and commuters. Traffic management will be in place to manage traffic and pedestrian movements.

The equipment required for these works will include a 12t excavator, bogie tipper, pavement saw cutter, concrete truck and pump, jackhammers, cherry picker, scissor lift, mechanical hoist, line removal/marketing machine, silenced lighting towers, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
