



Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Temporary site compound off Glenfield Road, Glenfield

Australian Rail Track Corporation will be constructing a temporary site compound off Glenfield Road, Glenfield as part of the Southern Sydney Freight Line project.

ARTC has been in consultation with the community and has considered the feedback received from the community survey to ensure that any potential impacts are minimised and the temporary site compound is harmonious with the local community. The comments received from the survey were provided to Liverpool City Council.

Establishment works for the compound **will commence from Friday 18 November 2011** and will take up to six weeks to complete, weather permitting. Works will involve the minor removal of vegetation along the Glenfield Road site access, the installation of additional stormwater pipes and the delivery of oversized sheds. Solid fences will be erected to the rear and sides of the compound to enclose the area and reduce the potential for noise and visual impacts to the community. During the construction of the temporary compound there may be an increase in truck and other machinery movements along Glenfield Road.

The compound is proposed to be in place for **approximately 18 months**. The site will be rehabilitated to its original state upon completion of the works.

The existing cyclists and pedestrian shared path between the residential properties and the temporary site compound will not be obstructed or used for vehicular entry or storage of materials at any time. All vehicles using the compound will enter the site from Glenfield Road. All vehicles will only be permitted to make a left turn into the compound from Glenfield Road and exiting the compound all vehicles will be directed to turn left onto Glenfield Road.

The temporary site compound will be operated in accordance with Office of Environment and Heritage requirements, between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. Office staff may access the compound outside of these hours to undertake administration tasks.

Community notifications will be distributed to the local community if we require to undertake construction activities 'out of hours'.
