

## Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

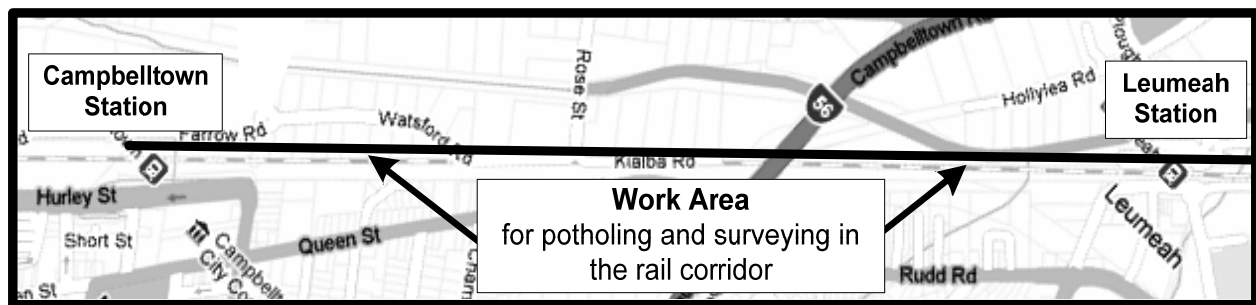
### Construction Works at Campbelltown

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled on 17 and 18 December 2011, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

#### Chester Road, Ingleburn to Campbelltown Station

Potholing and surveying works will take place from 7am Saturday 17 December to 6pm Sunday 18 December. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on Sunday 18 December 2011.

The equipment used will include pothole trucks, lighting towers, portable generators, a bobcat and site vehicles.

#### Sackville Street, Ingleburn to Rose Street, Campbelltown

Excavation and installation of temporary sheet piles will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday 17 December and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday 18 December 2011.

The equipment used will include a 5t hi-rail excavator, 8t hi-rail tipper, hi-rail pothole truck, sheet piling rig, truck and dogs, site vehicles, and powered and non-powered hand tools.

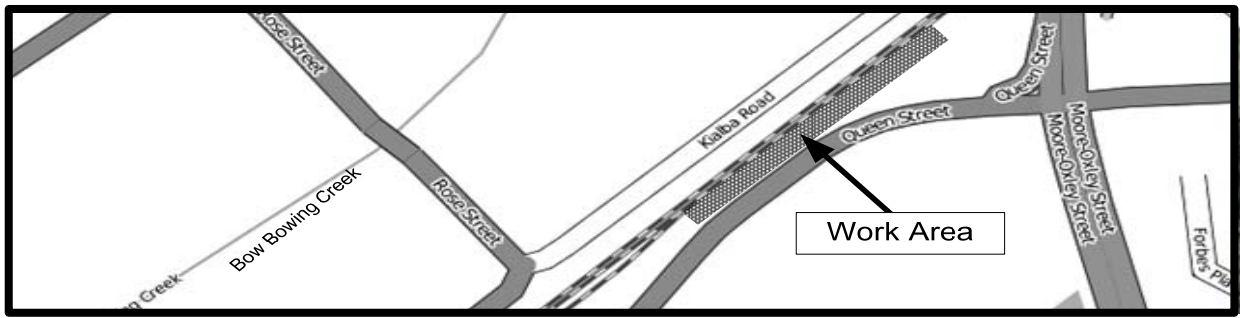


*Schematic showing work area from Leumeah Station to Campbelltown. Work areas around Leumeah Station and at Rose Street, Campbelltown.*

#### Queen Street, Campbelltown

Placement of precast culvert units into the existing creek will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday 17 December 2011. An approved contingency is in place from 8am to 6pm on Sunday 18 December 2011.

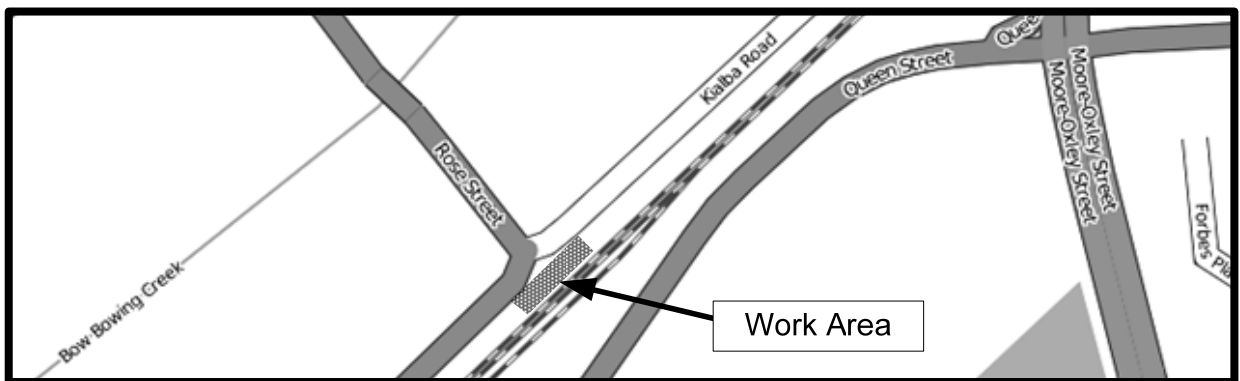
The equipment used will include a mobile slew crane, 20t franna, semi-trailer truck, 15t excavator, road sweeper, water cart, electrical breaker (for concrete breaking), generator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Kiaba Street, Campbelltown**

The removal of temporary shoring will take place from 7am on Saturday 17 December to 6pm on Sunday 18 December 2011. Two contingency weekends are approved from 7am Saturday to 6pm Sunday in January 2012.

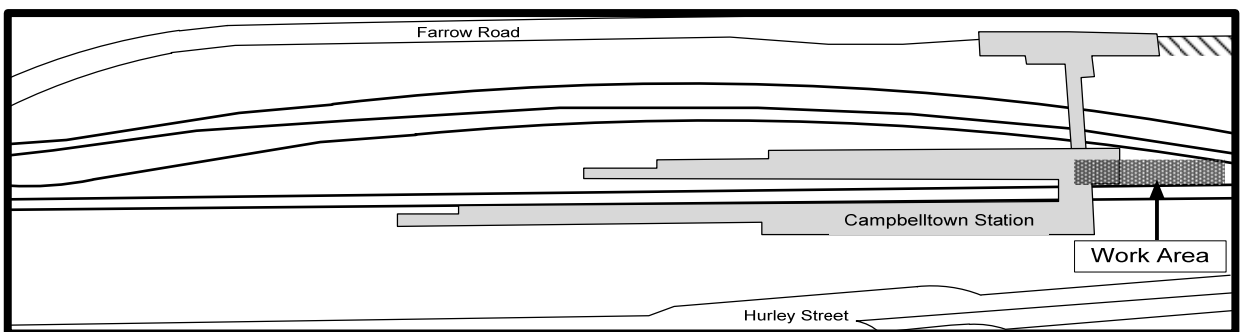
The equipment used will include a hi-rail excavator, oxy-acetylene set, 2t tipper, and powered and non-powered hand tools. A rail tamper and regulator will be used if required.



**Campbelltown Station**

Construction of a cable route, hauling of cabling and installation of a concrete slab will take place from 7am to 10pm on Saturday 17 December and from 8am to 10pm on Sunday 18 December 2011. Three approved contingency weekends are in place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012.

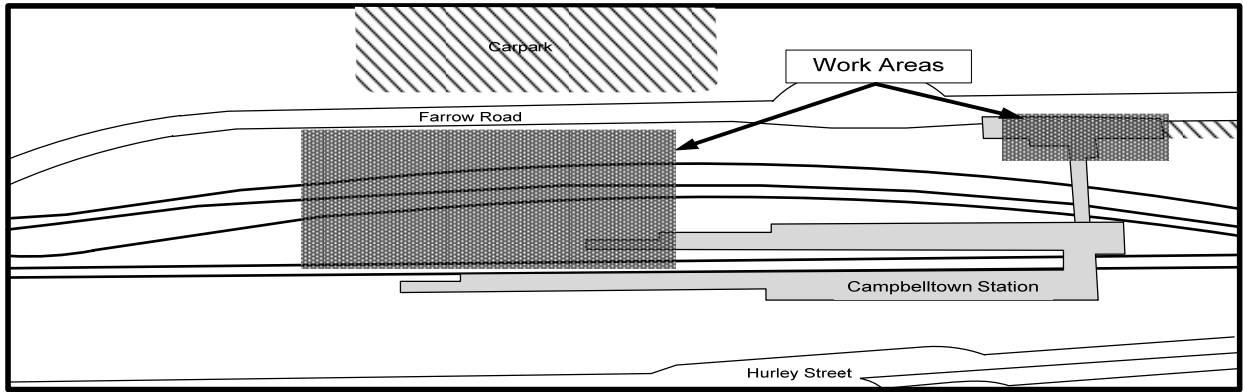
The equipment used will include a concrete truck, tip truck, excavator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Campbelltown Station**

Staff footbridge works and works under the existing pedestrian bridge, including piling, deflection wall works and installation of structural steel components, will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday 17 December and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday 18 December 2011. An approved contingency is in place from 6pm to 10pm on both days.

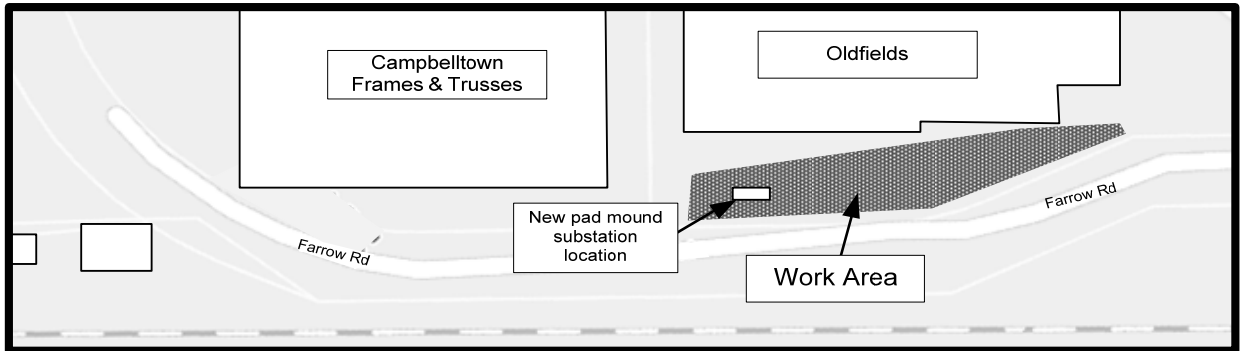
The equipment used will include a 100t crane, 20t franna, scaffolding, mobile elevated work platforms, concrete pump, oxy set, power saw, electric drill, generator, concrete saw, piling rig, high rail, knuckle boom, concrete vehicles, delivery vehicles, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



**Farrow Road, Campbelltown**

A pad mount is required to be relocated within the property boundary of Campbelltown Frames and Trusses on Farrow Road, Campbelltown. This work will take place over 48 hours of continuous work between 17 December 2011 and 29 February 2012. An approved contingency is in place for a second 48 hours within the same time period.

The equipment used will include a a 7t excavator, 2t tipper, concrete truck, concrete saw, generator, lighting towers, wacker pack, concrete vibrator, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
