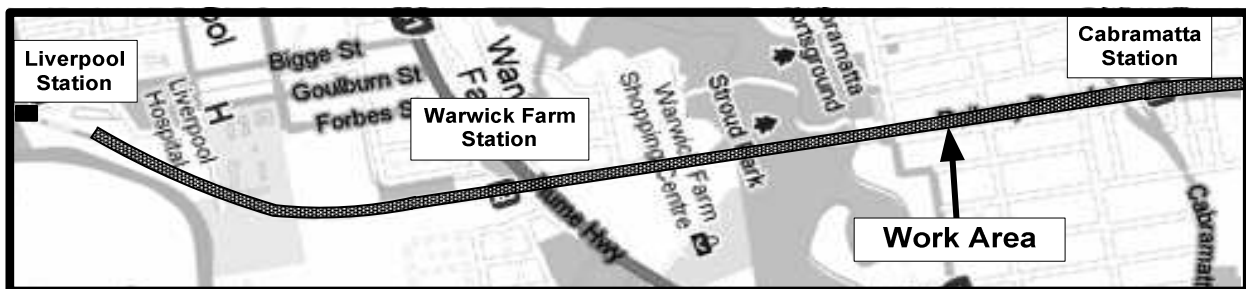
Construction Works from Liverpool to Casula

The Southern Sydney Freight Line Project (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled from 3 January to 22 January 2012, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

Broomfield Street, Cabramatta to Liverpool Hospital, Liverpool

Excavation and installation of noise wall posts and panels, drainage and cabling works, will be undertaken from 6pm to 10pm on weeknight evenings from Tuesday 3 January to Friday 20 January, and from 7am to 6pm on Saturdays and from 8am to 6pm on Sundays on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15 and 21-22 January 2012.

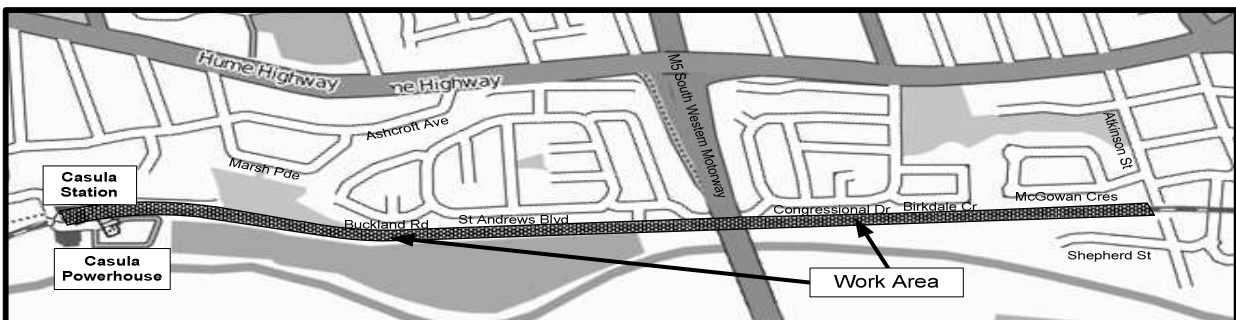
The equipment required for these works will include a small excavator and bob cat, piling rig, concrete agitator truck, concrete pump, 20t franna, elevated work platform, sucker truck, generators, compressor, jack hammer, demolition saw, lighting towers, 30t trench digger, hi-rail, excavators, 10t dumper/ tipper, bobcat/ backhoe, truck and dogs, 2t hino tipper truck, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Shepherd Street, Liverpool to Casula Powerhouse

Casula Access Road works, including clearing, earthworks, bulk earth movement, construction of retaining walls (including piling), shotcreting and anchoring, culvert works, drainage works, maintenance of access ramps and cycleway works, as well as high voltage works, including installation and removal of power poles with associated aerial works, will be undertaken from 7am to 6pm Saturday and from 8am to 6pm Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012.

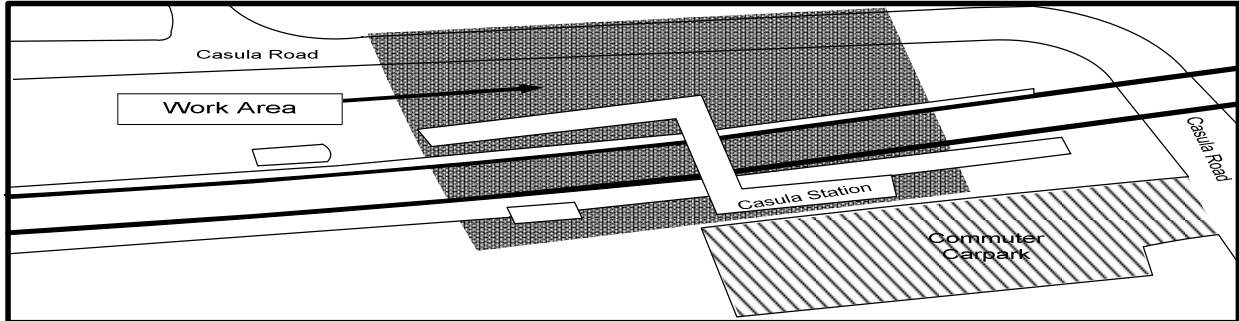
The equipment used will include pole trucks, elevated work platforms, excavators, compactors, rollers, bobcats, cranes, frannas, water cart, piling rig, trucks, dump trucks, concrete trucks, rollers, graders, boom pumps, anchoring rigs, generators, compressors, hydraulic hammers, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Casula Station

Station works, including bridge works, the extension of the deflection wall, works to lift shafts, platform works and a power upgrade, will take place from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on the weekends of 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22 January 2012. An approved contingency is in place for all days worked between Monday 2 January and Sunday 22 January 2012.

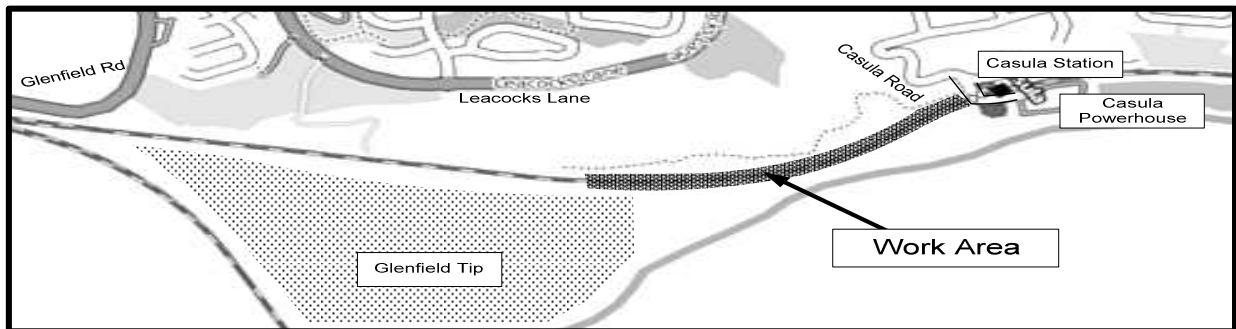
The equipment used will include a 100t crane, 20t franna, mobile scaffolding, elevated work platform, knuckle boom, concrete pump, generator, high rail, piling rig, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Casula Station to Glenfield Tip

Removal of redundant power poles will continue to be undertaken from 7am to 6pm on Saturday and from 8am to 6pm on Sunday on one weekend between Saturday 7 January 2012 and Sunday 22 January 2012.

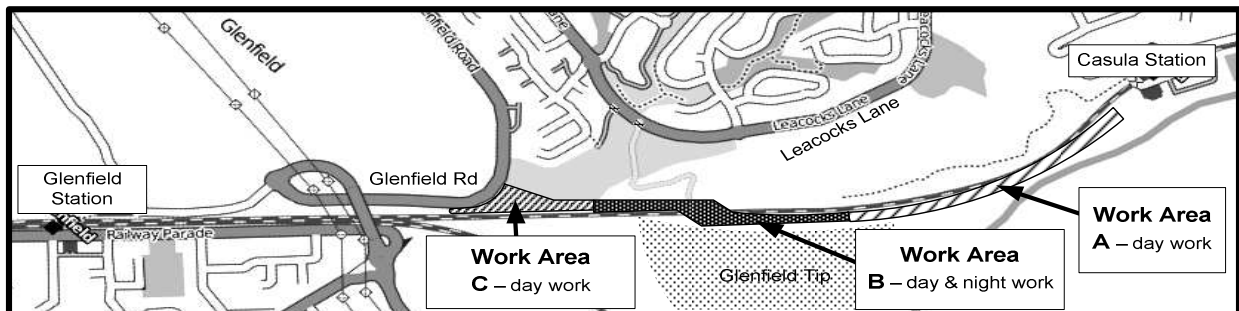
The equipment used will include a pole truck, two mobile cranes, an elevated work platform, and powered and non-powered hand tools.



Casula Station to Glenfield

Piling, retaining wall construction, earthworks, drainage works, installation of temporary access roads and level crossing, potholing, installation of flyover hoarding panels and concrete blocks, as well as overhead wiring works will be undertaken from 6am Tuesday 3 January to 10pm Sunday 22 January 2012. Night time work between 10pm and 7am will only be undertaken in Area B, as shown in the location map below.

The equipment used will include a 5t excavator, 8t tipper, two elevated work platforms, a pothole truck, piling rigs, excavators, truck & dogs, 100t crane, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, vibratory rollers, lighting towers, portable generators, and powered and non-powered hand tools.
