



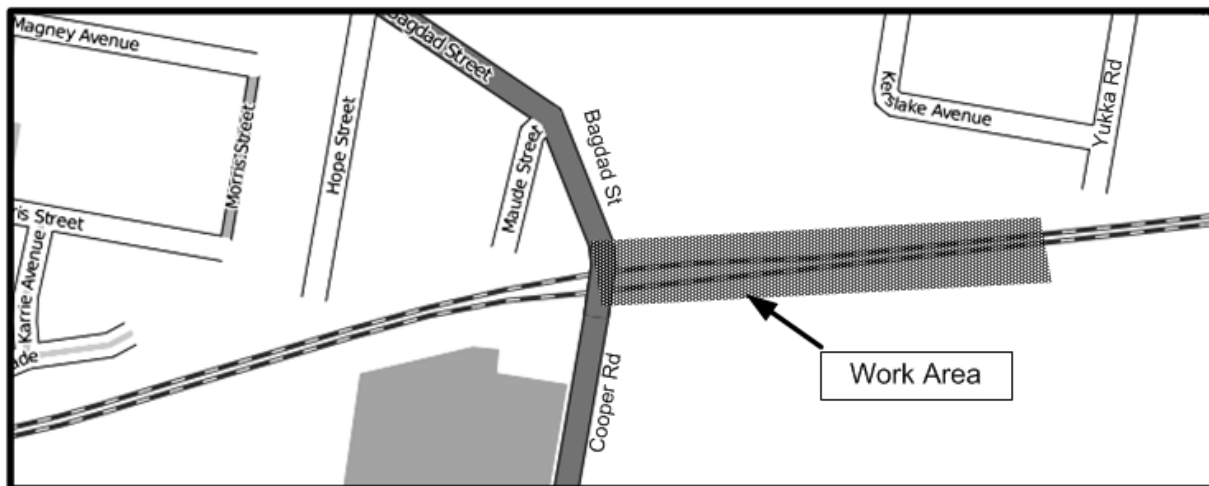
Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Construction work at Cooper Road, Bankstown

The Southern Sydney Freight Link Project (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled from 3 January to 22 January 2012, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

As part of this project ARTC will be undertaking work in the rail corridor east of Cooper Road, Birrong from **7am to 6pm Saturday 14 and 21 January 2012**, and from **8am to 6pm Sunday 15 and 22 January 2012**.

The work will include installing temporary support of services, removing rail track and cess drain, excavating drainage pipes and pits, backfilling around pipes and pits, reconstructing the cess drain, reinstating rail track, and removing temporary support of services. The equipment to be used will include two 14t excavators, 30t excavator, hi-rail excavator, dump trucks, bogie tipper, excavator mounted ballast tamper, rail grinders, oxysets and hand tools.
