



Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

Overhead wiring works, Ingleburn

The Southern Sydney Freight Link Project (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks. RailCorp has a track possession scheduled from 3 January to 22 January 2012, which means passenger trains won't be running on this weekend to allow construction work on the train lines. The Southern Sydney Freight line will utilise this track possession to undertake work safely.

As part of this project ARTC will be undertaking overhead wiring work in the rail corridor from Suffolk Street to Wellington Avenue, Ingleburn. The work will be undertaken from **7am to 10pm Saturday 14 and 21 January** and from **8am to 10pm Sunday 15 and 22 January 2012**.

The work will involve removing existing overhead wiring from a crossover, and removing overhead wiring structures and footings. The equipment to be used will include a hi-rail, crane, trucks, 12t excavator with hammer, generators, telescopic boom, generator and hand tools.
