



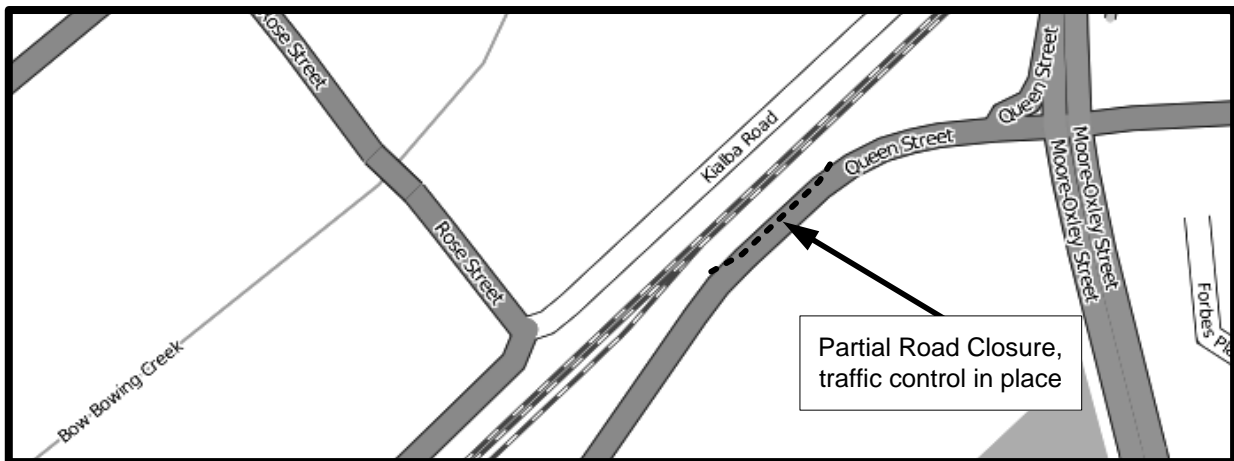
## Southern Sydney Freight Line IMPORTANT COMMUNITY INFORMATION

### Concrete culvert placement at Queen Street, Campbelltown

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) is currently constructing the Southern Sydney Freight Line. As part of this project ARTC will be undertaking work at Queen Street, Campbelltown, for which one lane of Queen Street will need to be closed from **7am to 5pm Saturday 14 January 2012**. An approved contingency is in place from 8am to 5pm Sunday 15 January 2012 if required.

The work will involve unloading culverts from a delivery truck and placing these into the rail corridor. The delivery work will be parked on Queen Street near the intersection of Campbelltown Road, Campbelltown. One lane on Queen Street will be closed to traffic whilst the delivery truck unloads the culverts using a 55t slew crane, which will be located in the rail corridor. The equipment to be used will include a mobile slew crane, 20t Franna crane, semi-trailer truck, 15t excavator, road sweeper, water cart, electrical breaker and generator.

Traffic controls will be in place to manage pedestrian and vehicular movements, with intermittent stoppages of up to five minutes for motorists. The bus stop and pedestrian crossing will be accessible at all times.
