Community Notification – Construction Access Along Bouddi Street

Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) in an Alliance with Leighton Contractors is delivering the Southern Freight Link (SFL). This work involves building a 36 kilometre bi - directional, non electrified, dedicated freight line from Leightonfield to Glen Lee in South Western Sydney.

To build the freight line, and as part of this work, SFL requires access to the rail corridor through designated access routes. Bouddi Street has been elected as one of the access routes. Construction vehicles will travel through Bouddi Street to gain access to the designated route along Bow Bowing Park.

Light work vehicles will commence using the access route along Bouddi Street, as shown on the map from **Wednesday 1 February 2012**. This route will be used from **Friday 3 February 2012** by larger construction trucks such as trucks with trailers, concrete trucks, Semi-trucks and when required crane trucks. The construction truck movements will be minimal until works require more trucks to access the rail corridor. It is anticipated an increase in movement will occur in approximately **April 2012 for up to 5 weeks**. We will keep you informed of changes in truck movements as the programme of work change.

Vehicular movement through Bouddi Street will occur between 7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am – 1pm Saturday; these movements are restricted to these times, which is within normal construction hours.

To minimise any potential impacts during the movement of the trucks, signage will be erected along Bouddi Street towards the entrance to the Bow Bowing Park, including caution signage in the park to allow cyclist and pedestrians to be aware of construction traffic movements and to commute safely along the cycle path. Truck drivers will be advised to be considerate of our neighbouring community and to adhere to all traffic regulations. We expect minimal delays for motorists during this time. We apologise for any inconvenience.
