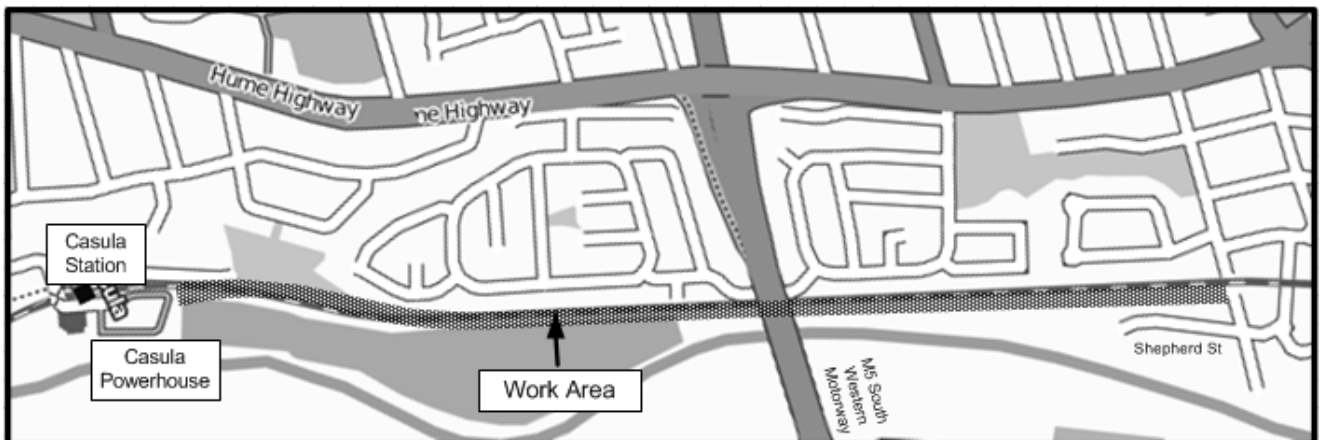


Southern Freight Link

Community Notification – Construction work, Liverpool to Casula

The Southern Sydney Freight Line Project (SSFL) will be undertaking construction work in your area. These works must be undertaken outside normal construction because there are safety risks involved with working in close proximity to the overhead wires and tracks.

Installing replacement power poles, associated aerial works and earthworks will be undertaken from **7am to 6pm Saturday 11 February, and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 12 February 2012**. A contingency is in place from **7am to 6pm Saturday 18 February, and from 8am to 6pm Sunday 19 February 2012**. The equipment required for these works will include a 5t excavator, 13t excavator, two 20t excavators, three 30t excavators, two compactors, three dump trucks, two rollers, two bobcats, two cranes, three Franna cranes, water cart, two pole trucks, four elevated work platforms, grader, generator and powered and non-powered hand tools.
